



Discussion: *PDS completes and posts to its external web site no later than April 1st of each year its EPEAT Annual Performance Report (APR). APRs are due April 1st in the calendar year following PDS's acceptance into the [now-suspended U.S. EPA Performance Track] program and annually thereafter. Should the Performance Track program be re-authorized, it will accept electronic report submissions at <https://yosemite.epa.gov/oepi/ptrack.nsf> and will post reports on the Performance Track website (www.epa.gov/performance-track). PDS should maintain the supporting documentation used to prepare this APR on-site, and PDS should make this documentation available to the U.S. EPA upon request.*

EMS Performance:

PDS launched its EMS program and published its EMS manual, based on the ISO 14001:2004 international standard, in June of 2009. PDS's environmental policy statement resides in that EMS manual. PDS's objectives and targets in support of that environmental policy are being defined and will be in place by the end of 2009. PDS's initial internal audit is scheduled for October 2009. This audit will be done in conjunction with PDS's semi-annual ISO 9001:2008 internal audit.

Goal Performance:

PDS is defining the environmental objectives and goals it will use. At a minimum, metrics will be tracked in the following areas (per Clause 4.3.3 of the PDS EMS Manual):

- Numbers of PDS PCs produced and configured from EPEAT-compliant platforms;
- Numbers of EPEAT-compliant platforms, divided by total numbers of PDS PC platforms;
- Some metric dealing with PDS deliveries using Rack N Roll;
- Some metric dealing with packaging.

Outreach Performance:

PDS is defining the substance of its environmental outreach program. That definition should be available by the end of 2009.

Self-Certification:

PDS meets the EPEAT criteria.
